#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF APPLICATION

By submitting an application for accommodation you are not automatically guaranteed an offer of accommodation in University residences. This is dependant on the eligibility or type of student applying, it is the applicants responsibility to ensure they have applied within advertised application deadline dates. Offers will be made subject to property availability and applicants' personal preference.

The information provided on your application form will act as a guide in the allocation of accommodation and whilst every effort will be made to match your requirements, Residential Services reserves the right to offer alternative accommodation or to refuse the allocation of accommodation for whatever reason.

Upon receipt of your on line application your student status will be checked against the student records system and offers of accommodation will be made to students who fulfil all conditions pertaining to the offer of study. Where a rent prepayment is required (new postgraduates) this must be paid during the on line application process and will be credited against the first due rent payment.

Offers of accommodation will be sent via your University email account and will expire if not responded to within the deadline date detailed in the offer. The offer will include details of the room, residence, rental payments and occupancy dates for the property you have been allocated.

All information contained in your application will be processed to meet the requirements of the Data Protection Act 1998. The University of Stirling is subject to, and will discharge obligations imposed on it under The Freedom of Information Act 2002.
